

Good care for your **fortte**™ case guide



The key to maintaining beautiful leather is proper care and conditioning. Neglect and harsh conditions are the primary causes of damage and deterioration of leather goods.

By following the **fortte**™ tips below, you can go a long way to extending the life and beauty of your case.

- Avoid humidity. Too high or too low humidity can cause leather to dry out and eventually crack.
- Keep your case clean and dust free.
- Try not to stretch out your leather good. Over stuffing or stretching out the leather may cause your case to lose its shape.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, furniture polish, varnish, detergents, and alcohol-based or ammonia-based products because they can discolor or possibly even damage the leather.
- Avoid using or placing sharp objects on leather goods. Leather is very durable, but not accident or damage proof.
- In case of spots and spills blot liquid instantly with sponge or absorbent cloth. Never leave to dry.
- Leather should never be exposed to water. If this occurs, leather should never be dried in front of a direct heat source as this damages the leather and also causes the hide to stiffen. Make sure to clean and treat your leather before it's dry. Never use heat to dry leather (it should air-dry).
- To clean the clear plastic on your case, use a lightly damp piece of cotton and gently Wipe clean. Avoid any type of commercial Cleaning products, since some Chemicals may burn or stain the plastic.
- Keep leather out of direct sunlight or it may dry out, causing it to crack and fade.
